Photography

Description:

Photography entries must be the work of an individual. This year all types of photography (digital, 35mm, black and white, color) are grouped into three subject areas: Still Life and Landscape, Life Studies, and Experimental.

All entries must adhere to the Cecil County Public Schools Media Technology Festival [2010 Guidelines](#) set forth on pages 1-3.

Subject Areas:

Each entry should be categorized according to subject area as follows:

1. Still Life and Landscape- representation of inanimate objects as well as plant life; general scenic landscapes, architecture; seascape, etc.
2. Life Studies- may include people or animals. Plant life should be included in Still Life and Landscapes
3. Experimental- include photos that have been manipulated or enhanced digitally or in the developing process

Print and Mount Sizes:

All prints must be individually adhered to mounting board or have photographic mat mounting. (An adult may help in the mounting of the photograph)

Only one photo should be mounted on a board. It should not be a collage of photos. Photos with frames or attached decorative (3D) materials will not be accepted.

Digital photographs that have been manipulated as well as 35mm photographs that have been enhanced in the developing process are considered experimental and should be placed in that category.

The following print and mount sizes apply to all photography categories except "Experimental." There is no limit on the size of an experimental entry.

Print size: no smaller than 3 1/2" x 5"- no larger than 16" x 20" (This minimum area must be clearly visible after print is mounted)

Mount size: no smaller than 5" x 7"- no larger than 24" x 30"
