Interactive Stills

Description:

An Interactive Stills production includes slides that are viewed in an order chosen by the viewer. Interactive Stills use navigation buttons and/or menus to enable the viewer to select a path. Text, music, video clips and narration may be incorporated into an Interactive Stills production. Media accepted is CD. We will accept purposeful story, documentary, and entertainment projects. **No Content Driven Factual Report Power Points will be accepted.**

All entries must adhere to the Cecil County Public Schools Media Technology Festival [2010](#) Guidelines set forth on pages 1-3.

Procedures:

- All entries from conception to final product, must be written and produced by the students entering the production.
- Special attention should be paid to copyrighted materials, as stated in the CCPS Media Technology Festival Guidelines, as well as being careful not to plagiarize.
- Entries should have a title and credits within the production.
- The source of any clip art used in the production should be cited within the production.
- If research is used, a bibliography of sources should be included in the production.
- The production should not exceed 7 minutes.
- If audio is used, make sure that entries are saved correctly so that the audio comes through when shown at the Media Technology Festival.
- Entries must be submitted on a CD. MAC format is preferred.
- One CD should be submitted per school, containing all projects. Name or rename the project the author's name and grade.
