

Competition #3

Video Sequential Stills

Description:

Video Sequential Stills is a series of still digital images along with computer graphics and enhancements that is placed in a production using computer technology, such as iMovie, iPhoto, PhotoStory 3, Power Point Movies, or similar computer programs. Claymation would be included in this competition. This competition includes no live action or motion digital pictures. Sound is an integral part of the production, therefore narration is suggested with appropriate background music. Production may not exceed 7 minutes.

All entries must adhere to the Cecil County Public Schools Media Technology Festival 2010 Guidelines set forth on pages 1-3.

Procedures:

- All entries from conception to final product, must be written, directed, and produced by the students entering the production. However, there is no age limit on the actors or performers who appear in the production.
- Special attention should be paid to copyrighted materials, as stated in the CCPS Media Technology Festival Guidelines, as well as being careful not to plagiarize.
- Entries should have a title and credits within the production.
- The source of any clip art used in the production should be cited within the production.
- For research projects, a bibliography of sources should be included in the production.
- Audio (narration, background music) is an integral part of the production and will be scored during judging.
- The production should not exceed 7 minutes. Any production exceeding 7 minutes will only be judged on the first 7 minutes.
- Entries may be submitted on VHS videotape or DVD.
