Graphic Design

Description:

The Graphic Design category includes 2-D art products generated with a microcomputer. Computer programs such as Kid Pix, Pixie, Microsoft Draw, Print Shop, etc. may be used to generate graphic design entries. Entries may include posters, CD covers, illustrations, diagrams, book jackets, advertisements, etc. Graphic Design entries must be the work of an individual.

All entries must adhere to the Cecil County Public Schools Media Festival [2010 Guidelines](#) set forth on pages 1-3.

Procedures:

Entries must be completely computer generated with no enhancements made using artistic tools. Artwork hand drawn and then scanned into the computer is not acceptable. The artwork should be mostly completed in freehand (within the computer program), with a minimum of clip art or stamps. Production may be in color or black and white. Entries may include text.

Special attention should be paid to copyrighted materials, as stated in the CCPS Media Technology Festival Guidelines. Clip art, stamps, graphics and fonts found within the computer program are allowable. Clip art and graphics found on the Internet are copyrighted and require written permission to use.

Entries must be mounted on construction paper, heavy stock, or mounting materials or they may be laminated. Entries must be 2-D. Entries with frames or attached decorative (3D) materials will not be accepted.

Print and Mount Sizes:

Print Size:

No smaller than 4" x 4"

No larger than 4 (four) 8 1/2" x 11" sheets of paper arranged vertically, horizontally, or grouped as a square. (44" x 8.5", 34" x 11", 17" x 22")

Mount Size:

No smaller than 6" x 6"

No larger than 24" x 30" (if 4 sheets of paper, vertically or horizontally mounted 48" x 12" or 38" x 15")

Subject Areas:

Graphic Design using Original Artwork: Artwork is entirely produced freehand and does not include any commercially produced graphics, stamps, or clip art. (Commercially produced fonts are acceptable in this subject area)

Graphic Design using Computer Clip Art: Artwork includes some commercially produced graphics, stamps, or clip art.
