Podcasts

Description:

A podcast is a digital audio program (created with programs such as Garage Band or Audacity) that can be downloaded and played on a computer or digital audio player. A podcast can be a stand-alone item or one of a series, though only one of the series should be submitted. Files should be in mp3 or mp4 format. RSS files are not required. Enhanced podcasts, with images, are accepted but will be considered equally with standard audio only podcasts. Video podcasts are not accepted in this category. Production may not exceed 7 minutes.

All entries must adhere to the Cecil County Public Schools Media Technology Festival [2010](#) Guidelines set forth on pages 1-3.

Procedures:

- All entries from conception to final product, must be written, directed, and produced by the students entering the production. However, there is no age limit on the actors or performers who appear in the production.
- Special attention should be paid to copyrighted materials, as stated in the CCPS Media Technology Festival Guidelines, as well as being careful not to plagiarize.
- Entries should have a title and credits within the production.
- The source of any clip art used in the production should be cited within the production.
- For research projects, a bibliography of sources should be included in the production.
- Audio (narration, background music) is an integral part of the production and will be scored during judging.
- The production should not exceed 7 minutes. Any production exceeding 7 minutes will only be judged on the first 7 minutes.
- Entries may be submitted on a CD or a downloaded file from a website.
