

Bibliography Format

REMEMBER: Put all citations in alphabetical order.
 Do not number the citations.
 Indent the second line of the citation.
 Spell out the names of months.

BOOK	Author's last name, First name. <u>Title of the Book</u> . City: Publisher, copyright date. (If there is more than one author, city or publisher, select only one for the citation. If your book only has an editor, use Editor's last name, First name, ed. in the citation.)
ENCYCLOPEDIA ARTICLE (PRINT)	Author's last name, First name. "Title of the article." <u>Name of Encyclopedia</u> , copyright date ed.
ENCYCLOPEDIA ARTICLE (ONLINE)	Author's last name, First name. "Title of the article." <u>Name of Encyclopedia</u> , copyright date ed. [Online].
INTERNET SITE	Author's last name, First name. <u>Title of the Site</u> . [Online] Available http://internet address, Date you visited the Site. (If you cannot find the author of the website, skip <i>Author's last name, First name</i> or use the organization name and proceed with all other information.)
MAGAZINE ARTICLE	Author's last name, First name. "Title of the Article." <u>Name of Magazine</u> , volume (date of magazine), pages.
MAGAZINE ARTICLE (ONLINE)	Author's last name, First name. "Title of the Article." <u>Name of Magazine</u> , volume (date of magazine), pages. [Online] Provider.
INTERVIEW	Interviewee's Last name, First name. Personal Interview. Date of Interview.
COMPUTER SOFTWARE	Author of the program (if known). <u>Title of Program</u> . Version. (Descriptive label.) Place of Production: Distributor, Year.
CLIP ART/GRAPHICS/ PICTURES (ONLINE)	Title or description of graphic. Format. Company name, current year. Example: Item #21872 (Giraffe). Jpg. Jupiterimages Corporation, 2006. Additionally, the following copyright notice should appear adjacent to the image: ©[current year] Company name
PERSONAL PHOTO OR VIDEO	Begin with a description of the photo. Do not use italics or quotation marks. Indicate who took the photo/video and the date it was taken.
